The increased popularity of mechanical installation of mulch through blower trucks and related machinery has been something we at Frey Lumber Co. Inc. have been involved in for over fifteen years.

These trucks use a process of mixing compressed air with organic products such as mulch, compost, sand and stone to force it through hoses, thereby "blowing" the product onto the application area. This machinery has become increasingly more reliable and cost effective in the past few years with the advent of new processes, machinery and technology, however, problems still exist.

Foreign debris matter such as rocks, stones and metal are highly detrimental to the mechanized process of mechanically installing organic products. In many cases, this foreign debris will not only greatly reduce the efficiency of the equipment, it can damage and destroy the machinery as well.

Our bulk mulch and compost is not loaded from a paved surface, so the possibility does exist of foreign matter being mixed into the product when loaded. We make every effort possible to reduce and eliminate foreign matter being integrated into our products, however, there is no way to fully ensure that some of this material is not mixed in with the product during the loading process. Additionally, there is no chain of custody of the product when it is off-loaded at a site and foreign debris can appear in the material once it is dumped on site.

Frey Lumber Company, Inc. makes no warranty or claim as to the absence of any material that could damage a mechanical installation device and will not be held liable should such damages occur.

Please understand that we will continue to make every effort possible to eliminate this problem, however the use of our product through mechanical installation is done so strictly at the risk and discretion of the customer.
